


Global Protein Consumption By Source

Canadian Per Capita Protein Consumption (2000-2012)


• Canadian low fish consumption patterns confirm global trends

• Between 2007-2012 direct employment dropped 18% and production increased 13.7%



• Norway produces six times the farmed salmon as Canada with approximately the same workforce


