How the EUB works from an intervener perspective

- The primary object of energy regulation is the public interest.
- Board decisions are based on the evidence on the record in the proceeding.
- The intervener's role is to help the Board, not the other way around.
- The process works best when we are well informed and responsibly engaged.

The process works best when we are well informed and responsibly engaged.

- Well informed means understanding the matter, reviewing the evidence and becoming familiar with the hearing process.
- Responsible engagement means thoughtful participation that is relevant, probative, nonduplicative and respectful.
