HERBICIDES & WILDFIRES CYCLE

FUEL LOAD INCREASE

<u>Herbicides kill grasses</u>, shrubs and other plants, leaving dry, dead plant matter that fuels wildfires.

REMOVAL OF NATURAL FIRE BREAKS

<u>Deciduous trees</u> act as natural fire breaks, and removing these fire-resistant species creates more fire-prone monocultures.

DIVERSITY REMOVAL

Lack of diversity allows wildfires to spread more rapidly and intensely, as fires in coniferous forests are less likely to be slowed down.
